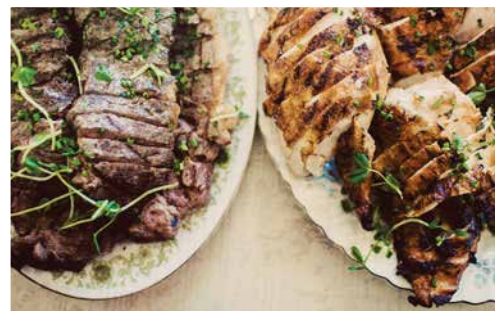

South Pond Farms is a beautiful country venue with a restored century barn and stunning fields and gardens. Use of the barn is available from mid-May to the end of September. South Pond Farms is a full service venue providing our own food, bar, florals, decorations and planning services. Our unique farm setting, the care we take in the details, the delicious local food and broad wine, craft beer and spirit offerings makes South Pond the perfect location for your celebration.





Choosing South Pond as your wedding venue gives you exclusive use of our 150-year-old restored barn and property up to a capacity of 120 guests. A description of what is included in the South Pond venue fee is outlined below.

## About the Venue

### Property

- Large outdoor cocktail reception area surrounded by gardens and panoramic views of the property
- Stone oven and handcrafted copper bar available for appetizers and cocktails
- Outdoor garden games included for cocktail reception
- Iron tables, chairs and adirondack chairs available for outdoor seating
- Outdoor bon-fire as an optional add-on
- Exceptional washrooms just outside the barn with heated floors and chandeliers
- Unlimited breathtaking photo opportunities on site
- SOCAN fees and P.A.L. insurance
- Wheelchair accessible barn and washrooms and assistance to the ceremony for elderly guests
- Beautiful cottage for the couple to stay the night prior to their wedding as well as the night of. Use the cottage for the day with the bridal party and family to get ready. The cottage comes equipped with full length mirrors, shower, sauna, bathrobes, coffee and tea, flutes and wine cooler
- All South Pond planning services and day of coordination, not including coordination of any external vendors
- Complimentary engagement photo shoot and ceremony rehearsal by appointment

### Inside the Barn

- Antique chandeliers, bistro strand lights and spotlights
- Handcrafted harvest tables with mismatched antique wooden chairs
- Antique mismatched dishes, platters and tea cups. Glassware, cutlery and linen napkins
- Magnificent licensed bar (see bar packages for more information)
- Sound system with wireless microphone
- Historic ceramic tile silo available for optional specialty uses such as a silo bar, photo booth, gift area, signing table

### Ceremony

Choice between three options:

- Hilltop ceremony space overlooking the pond
- Forest ceremony within the cedar grove (limited number of guests, not wheelchair accessible)
- Candlelit ceremony inside the barn. Also available during inclement weather

Our live-edge bar is an iconic feature of our barn. We have two draft beer taps and create all our cocktails and syrups from scratch using herbs and fruits from our farm and neighbouring farms. We have incorporated many local breweries, wineries and distilleries into our menu.

Our bar packages include use of an outdoor wooden bar where we serve your choice of signature cocktails, beer and non-alcoholic punch for cocktail receptions as well as our fully stocked indoor bar that includes bitters, liquers and mixers, for your dinner, reception and dance.

## *Bar Packages*

### *Cash Bar*

Guests are responsible for purchasing their own drinks.

### *Drink Tickets*

Pre-purchase a set number of drink tickets. Tickets cover all drinks with the exception of top shelf. Guests are responsible for purchasing all other drinks.

Charged for the drinks consumed by guests throughout the event. The bar menu may be selected as standard, premium or everything including top shelf.
